## **Key barriers to future attainment:**

Low levels of literacy and maths result in pupils unable to access the age-related curriculum without scaffolding and support Children with EAL do not have sufficient English to access the curriculum

## In the event of part or full school closures:

Children's computing and keyboard skills need to improve in order that they can fully benefit from remote learning Remote/home learning is difficult for children who do not have sufficient devices, data or the environment to fully engage in learning
